## **Survey Method**

The **Healthy School Meals for All Poll – February 2024** results are based on an online poll of registered voters in Colorado. The sample is distributed to accurately represent registered voters in Colorado based on party registration, gender, age, region, education, and ethnicity. The worst-case margin of error at the 95% level for the full sample of 500 respondents is plus or minus 4.4%. The poll was conducted from February 15-22, 2024, by Keating Research, Inc.
